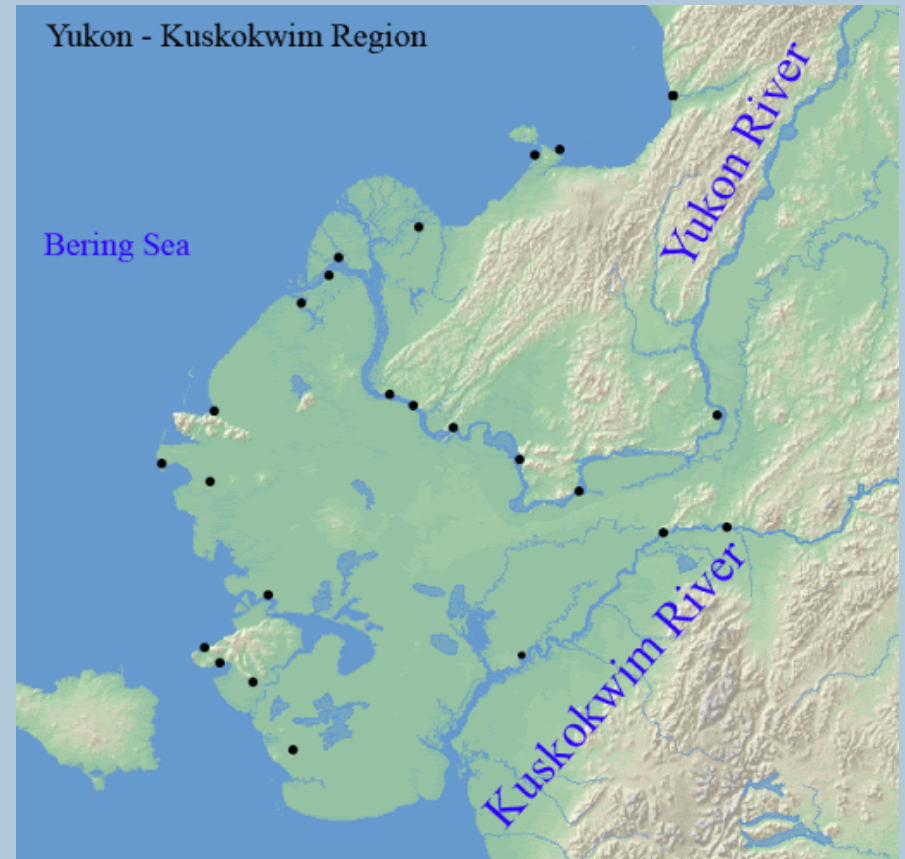

P R O P O S A L

- Planned Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta Regional Tribal Government (RTG)
- Would span the territory between Kuskokwim and Yukon Rivers and Bering Sea
- The RTG would be of limited powers that are not intended to infringe upon the sovereignty or interfere with the powers of any tribal government within the region

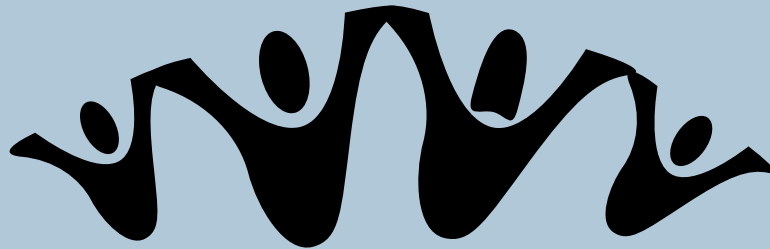

YUKON-KUSKOKWIM DELTA REGIONAL TRIBAL GOVERNMENT

WHAT THEY NEED YOU TO DO

- The 56 Tribal governments who reside in the area of the proposed RTG are to vote by Resolution to approve or oppose the proposed government
- If a significant number of YK Tribal governments support formation of the RTG, then the first RTG meeting can come together to select an interim Regional Tribal Council and begin its work on behalf of the People of our Region.
